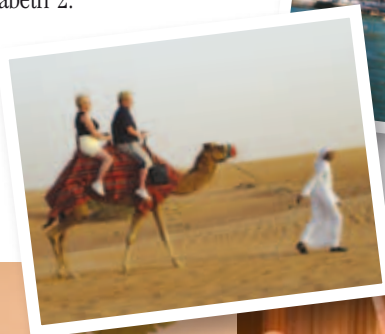

General information and booking conditions

International touring can involve a considerable amount of walking and stair climbing in the places visited and it is important that all tour participants have a level of physical fitness that allows them to take part in this activity without the need of assistance from others.

TOUR OPERATOR: Travelrite International Pty Ltd (ABN 64 005 817 078) is the tour organiser.

Queen Elizabeth, and Queen Mary 2 are operated by Cunard Line Limited and the fly, cruise & stay arrangements are subject to the terms and conditions and general information detailed in the Cunard World Cruise 2012 brochure. All passengers must complete and sign a Cunard Cruises Reservation form as well as a Travelrite booking form.

DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT: A deposit of \$1,500 per passenger should be sent with a booking form that lists your requested cabin category. As soon as the booking is confirmed (usually within 24 hours) a cruise confirmation advice will be posted to the client. The confirmation advice will contain all details. The passenger must also complete and return a Cunard reservation form to Travelrite. Final payments are due to be paid to Travelrite International 90 days prior to the commencement of the Cunard fly/cruise/stay holiday.

General – A 1% administration fee will be added to all payments made by Visa and Master Card. 3% administration charge will be added to payments by Amex and Diners. If fares and air taxes change due to government and airport regulations and currency fluctuations Travelrite reserves the right to charge additional amounts.
